Making it possible for area veterans to visit war memorials in Washington, D.C. is a driving force behind Warren Vincent's business.

Promoted on Facebook at his page, "Cans4KansasHonorFlight," Mr. Vincent has been responsible for sponsoring nearly 40 veterans in the past four years by collecting and selling aluminum cans throughout Central Kansas.

The Kansas Honor Flight serves veterans from World War II, Korea and Vietnam by providing airfare, food, lodging and ground transportation to all the war memorials and other points of interest in Washington, D.C. Donations pay for their travel, which has a value of \$700.

As a result of his efforts, Mr. Vincent is recognized as The Citizens State Bank/Home State Bank Hometown Hero for this quarter.

"Warren collects cans, smashes them, bags them, loads them, hauls them to Hutchinson and sells them to collect money for Kansas Honor Flights," wrote Linda Herring, who submitted his name for the award. "He set up collections throughout McPherson County. In 2011, he funded two veterans; 2012, he funded four-plus veterans; 2013, eight veterans and 2014, 17 veterans. (In 2015, he funded) seven veterans."

Hometown Hero is a quarterly award, sponsored by The Citizens State Bank/Home State Bank, honoring area residents who make a difference in their communities through volunteerism. Recipients receive a framed certificate and \$50 gift card.
